ASSISTANT CLERK: Read record vote found on page 2088 of the Journal. 26 ayes, 15 nays, 7 excused and not voting, Mr. President, 2 present and not voting.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: LB 38 passes. LB 38A. This one, Senator DeCamp, won't take very long. This next one won't take very long. The next one, afterwards, is the one that I referred to. LB 38A on Final Reading.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read title to LB 38A.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Senator Bereuter, as Vice Chairman of the Appropriations Committee, would you advise the body as to whether this will require 30 votes or 25 votes.

SENATOR BEREUTER: Mr. President, it would require 30 votes since it was not in the Governor's budget.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Alright. So it requires 30 votes. All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass. It requires 30 votes. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read record vote found on page 2089 of the Journal. 31 ayes, 11 nays, 7 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: LB 38A passes. Now the Clerk will read some matters in.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, we have a correspondence from the Governor. (Read correspondence found on pages 2039 and 2090 of the Journal regarding LB 182, 257, 257A, 263, 263A, and 544). Mr. President, your Committee Enrollment and Review reports that we have carefully examined engrossed LB 4, 346 and 542, and find the same correctly engrossed.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Clerk will proceed then with the Final Reading of LB 39.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read title to LB 39.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: All those excused return to their desks. We're ready to vote on LB 39. All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read record vote found on pages 2091 and 2092 of the Journal. 31 ayes, 11 nays, 4 excused and not voting, 3 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: LB 39 passes. The Clerk will read in some things.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Hefner would like to be excused this afternoon at 2:30 p.m. for the balance of the day.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Senator Hefner. Alright. It is so ordered. No objections. So ordered. The Clerk will now read, on Final Reading, LB 40. This is also a very long bill. Senator Barnett.
