SENATOR GEORGE: Mr. Speaker, members. I rise in support of Senator Duis' motion, which I believe is temporarily dead. We would like to see it revived. I believe you have had the same experiences, in the last years, that I have had. When the session is over we have to come back to Lincoln, we have to have committee meetings because there are problems somewhere that the laws are not carried out properly, or at least our intent is not carried out. There are some problems with rules and regulations. That takes a lot of your time. And as mentioned previously, there are a lot of complaints from your constituents too. I think we have to get a better hold on supervision of rules and regulations. I believe with Senator Duis' amendment that can be done. I hope you support Senator Duis' motion.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Senator Koch, is there any close?

SENATOR KOCH: No closing, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Alright. Motion is the adoption of the Duis amendment since we are now reconsidering. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 9 nays on the motion to adopt.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: There are no further amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: I move 550 be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Motion is that LB 550 be advanced to E & R for engrossment. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. LB 550 is advanced to E & R for engrossment.

CLERK: Mr. President, a series of things on the desk. Your Committee Enrollment and Review reports we have examined and reviewed LB 38, 38A, 39, 40, 41, 340, and 524 and find the same correctly enrolled. Signed, Senator Cullan.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: While the Legislature is in session and capable of doing business I propose to sign and do sign LB 38, 38A, 39, 40, 41, 340, and 524.
