CLERK: Mr. President, I move to return LB 546 to Select File for specific amendment. Signed Senator Warner. Read amendment. (See page 2128, Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Senator Warner, 546.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move the bill be returned. This is a technical correction in the amendment the other day that was offered. I think Senator Bereuter explained it and it dealt with the coal fire of utilities for the Penal complex area and the way the amendment was written why it would have not permitted some utilities that will be necessary for the minimum-maximum security unit to be spent with that unit. I guess the assumption was that this was to be put in by the end of the year. It would have presented no problem but apparently the construction for that will not be completed by then. It makes no change in money. It doesn't change the intent of any of the language but it assures that \$188,400 is available and is meant to go for the minimum-maximum security unit. It is to hook up utilities. I move the bill be returned for the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: All right, Senator Warner, anything else? All right, any further discussion? All in favor then... That is your close then, Senator Warner. All in favor of the Warner motion to return LB 546 vote aye, opposed nay. It requires 25 votes. Has everybody voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes on the motion to return.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: LB 546 is returned, Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move the amendment be adopted.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Senator Warner moves for adoption. Any further discussion. All in favor then vote aye, opposed nay on the adoption of the Warner amendment to LB 5... problem with the machine. Just a moment. Hold up.

CLERK: Mr. President, the motion to return was adopted.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The motion to return was adopted. The motion now is the adoption of the Warner amendment on LB 546. Ready. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? We have a number of motions yet this afternoon so if you want to get out of here you had better vote. It still requires 25 votes. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The Warner amendment is adopted. Motion, Senator Cullan.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move that LB 546 as amended be advanced to E & P for engrossment.
