

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Chair recognizes Senator Simon.

SENATOR SIMON: I move the previous question.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Question has been called for. Do I see five hands? I do. All those in favor of ceasing debate vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted?

CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Debate ceases. Senator Koch, will you close. You're waiving closing. The motion is to advance to E & R. Call of the House. Alright. All those in favor of a Call of the House vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 22 ayes,

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: House is under Call. All legislators will return to their desks and register their presence. Senator Swigart, are you here? Senator Dick Lewis, is he here? When? Now. Alright. Commence the roll call. Read the question again, it's been so long.

CLERK: The motion is to advance 532 to E & R Final. (Took roll call vote found on pages 2160 and 2161 of the Journal). 26 ayes, 12 nays.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: LB 532 is advanced to E & R for engrossment.

CLERK: Mr. President, we do have another motion to return 532 that you may or may not want to consider. They can't do any work on it until you decide what you're going to do with the bill. Well just before you recess, Mr. President, your Committee Enrollment and Review reports we have examined and reviewed LB 542 and find the same correctly enrolled. Signed, Senator Cullan.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Senator Barnett. Just a moment. Let me sign this first. While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business I propose to sign and I do sign LB 542.

CLERK: Mr. President, a letter from the Secretary of State acknowledging receipt of the communication forwarding LB 33.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Senator Barnett.

SENATOR BARNETT: I was going to try to move to recess until 1:30.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Motion to recess until 1:30. All in favor say aye, opposed nay. Maybe you would like to have a vote on the board on that. No. We stand in recess.
