PRESIDENT: Senator Murphy, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR MURPHY: I guess a point of personal privilege Mr. Chairman.

PRESIDENT: State your point.

SENATOR MURPHY: I am in receipt of a letter from the World Herald addressed to Senator George Murphy, wanting to know if I would send in advance a copy of my financial condition which is at the moment disastrous. However he wanted to get some kind of advance reply and I would like to tell him that I am not song and dance Murphy, I'm the cheerful one, but more than that, the law provides, I believe, under Subsection 93, that the recording date shall be April 1st for the prior year. The law goes into effect in July. I have no intention of telling anyone anything about my disastrous condition until next April and further that the Section he refers to indicates that the report shall be made to the Commission on forms provided by the Commission.

PRESIDENT: That was a letter from a Nebraska newspaper?

SENATOR MURPHY: Yes sir.

PRESIDENT: I overrule your point of personal privilege. Thank you Senator Murphy.

CLERK: Mr. President 220A has Select File amendments that should be considered.

PRESIDENT: Are we going to work with Senator Dworak on this? What have you got up first Mr. Clerk? Alright, the first one, Mr. Clerk.

SENATOR DWORAK: I move the E & R amendments to 220A.

PRESIDENT: Discussion? All in favor say aye, contrary say nay. They are adopted.

SENATOR DWORAK: I move that 220A be advanced to Final.

PRESIDENT: All in favor say aye, contrary say nay. The bill is advanced.

CLERK: Now Mr. President, your committee on E & R reports that we have examined and reviewed LB 220A and find the same correctly engrossed. Signed, Senator Cullan, Chairman.

Mr. President, LR 116, 117 and 118 will be put into the Journal and referred to the Executive Board.

That is all the reports that I have. Do you wish to revert to motions?

PRESIDENT: Yes.

CLERK: Mr. President, motion on the desk.

PRESIDENT: Read the motion.

CLERK: Read Rasmussen motion regarding LB 549.
