

technique would be to resist a motion on that bill alone and ask that that be not included in the whole list, but I would suggest that when the motion to suspend the rules to take up 273 comes up, you ask that a special motion be made for 273 and the Chair would say that that was in order and then you can win or lose on a suspension of rules. Okay then you withdraw your motion to lay it over to the first?

SENATOR SAVAGE: I withdraw it.

PRESIDENT: Do you have a motion Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, I move to suspend the rules, Rule 6, Section 6b to consider the Final Reading bills set for June 1 at this time.

PRESIDENT: Senator Savage.

SENATOR SAVAGE: I ask to exclude 273 from that order.

PRESIDENT: Well that would be in order to take that separately. Senator Luedtke may we take this up separately then?

SPEAKER LUEDKTE: Yes.

PRESIDENT: So the motion is to suspend the rules for 273 itself first. Then we will take the entire list. Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President and colleagues, I would like to ask Senator Savage we have been hearing of the dire need for this bill, and I would like to know his rationale for laying this over until Wednesday.

SENATOR SAVAGE: That is the rationale, the dire need for it, we need the Emergency Clause on it and there are six people missing today from the Chamber. You are correct there is a dire need for it.

SENATOR DWORAK: Senator Savage, I have some amendments on the bill and these amendments might be very pertinent and I'm afraid that if these amendments do not get adopted today the chances are that the bill will go Wednesday without an opportunity to get the amendments for the passage of the bill. So, I think that these amendments are pertinent enough and need to be debated and I will object to laying this bill over until then.

PRESIDENT: Senator Dworak there is no motion to lay it over. The Speaker has eliminated 273 from the Speakers order.

SENATOR DWORAK: I would be opposed to eliminating 273 from the Speakers order.

PRESIDENT: That is not your prerogative Senator Dworak, that is the Speaker's and he has eliminated that from the list. So the motion to suspend the rules to allow the Final Reading for certain bills now does not include 273. So your only prerogative then is to appeal the Speakers order of deleting 273.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, those bills that will be read today, that are scheduled to be read Wednesday, is there a list of those bills?
