

PRESIDENT: Yes, on the agenda, I think.

CLERK: It is also on the worksheet. Both places.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I note on that list that LB532 is on that list and that can not be read today because it has not had one intervening day on the floor, in the bill books.

PRESIDENT: I'll be glad to discuss that with you but I think we had better, excuse me Mr. Speaker, Senator Dworak, I think that we have got to conclude our discussion on 273. It is the Chair's position that your only alternative is to appeal the Speaker's order. Otherwise 273 will not be included in the motion to suspend the rules. Now I want to give you an opportunity to appeal the Speaker's rule if you want.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I'll have to make that appeal because I haven't had a chance to visit with the Speaker but I do have amendments on 273 and I'm afraid that if these amendments are discussed today, Wednesday will be too late to discuss them all and I would appeal the Speaker's order and move that 273 be included in that list of bills that are...

PRESIDENT: You don't need to remove that. If you are successful in over ruling the Speaker's order and the Speaker's order is to delete it from his previous order. Now, we can spend a great deal of time discussing this particular issue but the Chair at this time will recognize the Speaker.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Mr. President, the only reason that we are doing this is that Senator Savage has requested this. Senator Dworak as far as your being able to bring it back for amendments, I know of nothing that keeps you from doing what you want to do on that. You can bring it back anyway because that is just going to be read on next Wednesday. You have your right to bring it back anytime you want to, on a motion, you can bring it back for amendment. Senator Savage can't keep you from making a motion to bring it back today. That is just for the time that it is going to be read. Do you understand me?

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. Speaker if we bring it back Wednesday for an amendment or are successful in bringing it back and amending it, it would be too late for that bill. So, this is what I am trying to avoid Mr. Speaker and that is why I would like to discuss it today.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: You can bring it back today. There is nothing keeping you from bringing it back.

SENATOR DWORAK: When would that motion be in order today?

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: When we are through with Final Reading.

SENATOR DWORAK: Thank you Mr. Speaker. I'll have a motion on the desk.

PRESIDENT: Alright, do you want to proceed or appeal the Speaker's order?
