PRESIDENT: I've had a parliamentary and culinary inquiry from a senator. Senator Merz, they want to know if there is any rum or any other alcohol in this cake? Please read LB 530.

CLERK: Well Mr. President, there's LR 128, I guess just directing the Executive Board to take action. That will be read and laid over, Mr. President.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read title to LB 530.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 530 pass with the emergency clause attached. Record your vote. Have you all voted? Record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read record vote found on pages 2213 and 2214 of the Journal. 40 ayes, 0 nays, 7 excused and not voting, 2 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 530 passes with the emergency clause attached. ASSISTANT CLERK: Read title to LB 537.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read record vote found on page 2214 of the Journal. 38 ayes, 0 nays, 7 excused and not voting, 4 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill is passed. Please read LB 531.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read title to LB 531.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 539 pass with the emergency clause attached. Have you all voted? Record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read record vote found on page 2216 of the Journal. 39 ayes, 0 nays, 7 excused and not voting, 3 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 539 passes with the emergency clause attached. Mr. Speaker.
