LB 543, 549, 33A

SENATOR WARNER: That's perfectly alright.

CLERK: I don't know what you're referring to as Bereuter's motion. He doesn't even have one here.

PRESIDENT: Do you have a motion up here, Senator Bereuter?

SENATOR BEREUTER: No, I inquired about LB 543. There are three motions on it however. I could not make one.

PRESIDENT: Alright. Do you have a motion on 543?

CLERK: Lots of them, yes. First one is offered by Senator DeCamp who is no longer with us. The second one is offered by Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: My motion...it's a motion to reconsider but I want it with the E clause. So since the motion is already up there, can they put the E clause on it.

CLERK: I'm sorry, Senator. Your motion reads with the E clause stricken.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Right. I don't want it to read like that. I want it to read with the E clause included. Yes. You see Senator DeCamp had the E clause on his. So since he's gone could I just make my motion read to reconsider the bill with the E clause.

PRESIDENT: Alright. That is the matter now. The reconsideration of the action taken by the Legislature.

CLERK: It failed to pass.

PRESIDENT: LB 543 failed to pass or obtain the constitutional majority with the emergency clause attached. Senator Chambers asks that our action be reconsidered. So that is the question, shall we reconsider that action. Record your vote. This requires 33 votes. Record.

CLERK: 37 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Alright. Now the question is.... There is a debate. The question is shall LB 543 pass with the emergency clause attached. Record your vote. All senators are to be at their desks. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: Read record vote found on page 2249 of the Journal. 43 ayes, 0 nays, 6 not voting.

PRESIDENT: LB 543 passes with the emergency clause attached.

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee Enrollment and Review reports we have examined and reviewed LB 549 and find the same correctly enrolled.

PRESIDENT: While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business I propose to sign and do hereby sign LB 549.

CLERK: Mr. President, I move to consider LB 33 on Final Reading. Signed, Senator Cullan. Consider LB 33A.

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
