

PRESIDENT: Do I see five seconds? I do. The question is shall debate now cease. Record your vote. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 1 nay.

PRESIDENT: The question is shall LR 102 be indefinitely postponed. Record your vote. Have you voted? Have you voted? Record.

CLERK: 7 ayes, 21 nays.

PRESIDENT: Motion fails.

CLERK: The next motion I have, Mr. President, is to indefinitely postpone by Senator Newell.

PRESIDENT: We've already had one. Okay. Motion on the resolution? Senator Lewis is calling for the question on the resolution. Do I see five seconds? The question is shall debate now cease on the resolution. Yes, we could. Well let us get it established. Record your vote. Motion is to cease debate. Debate ceases on the adoption of the resolution. Well he debated originally. There will be no closing because there was no opposition on your motion to adopt. So the question now is the adoption of this resolution. Record your vote. Have you voted? Please vote. Record. Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: How many are excused, Mr. President?

PRESIDENT: One. Is Senator Kelly excused? Yes. There is one that is absent.

SENATOR DeCAMP: You can't take call in votes now. Is that right? I move to go under Call.

PRESIDENT: Okay. The question now is shall this House go under Call. Record your vote. Have you voted on this proposition?

CLERK: Senator Hefner voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Let's vacate going under Call. We're no longer under Call. Alright, we are under Call. Now the question is shall we lift the Call. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 13 ayes, 4 nays to raise the Call.

PRESIDENT: Report the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, Mr. President, 3 nays, 16 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The resolution is adopted. The Call is raised.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I'd like a record vote.

PRESIDENT: In the Journal. It is so ordered. Senator Marvel, for what purpose do you ask recognition?

SENATOR MARVEL: I'd like to introduce a guest underneath the South balcony, and indicate that there will be some pamphlets passed out to you, and identify them if I might. Is that alright, Mr. President?
