LB 406, 406A

SENATOR MARVEL: Do you want to make a motion to advance the bill as amended?

SENATOR MOYLAN: I made the motion that it be advanced to E & R Initial.

SENATOR MARVEL: Is there a second to the motion? Okay. All those in favor of advancing LB 406 as amended vote aye, opposed vote no. Voting aye, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Marvel voting aye.

SENATOR MARVEL: Have you all voted? Clerk record the vote.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance.

SENATOR MARVEL: The motion is carried and the bill is advanced. The next bill is LB 329. Excuse me. Mr. Clerk, go ahead.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 406A - read title. I do have pending amendments, Mr. President. The amendment reads as follows: Read amendment to LB 406A found on page 175 of the Legislative Journal. Those are offered by Senator Moylan.

SENATOR MARVEL: Senator Moylan, do you want to speak to, do you move the adoption of these amendments to 406A?

SENATOR MOYLAN: I move the adoption of the amendments to 406A.

SENATOR MARVEL: Is there a second to that motion? Okay. Senator Moylan, do you wish to speak to those amendments.

SENATOR MOYLAN: This was an updating of the fiscal analyst's office on the fiscal bill, the fiscal note, on this 406. So I move that the amendments to LB 406A be adopted.

SENATOR MARVEL: Is there any other discussion on the amendments? You have heard the motion. All those in favor of, we are voting on the amendments, right, all those in favor. I am sorry. Senator Murphy, do you wish the floor?

SENATOR MURPHY: I was curious as to the occasion for the change and how it was arrived at. The original provision for \$5,000 in general fund and four from the apparent cash fund of the audiologists and speech pathologists. I wonder what occasion the change in the funding, how it was arrived at, I guess?

SENATOR MARVEL: Senator Moylan, do you wish to respond?

SENATOR MOYLAN: The Department of Health it is, I believe, Rex Higley, updated the fiscal note on it, that is all, and there is no definite figure of how many will be licensed and they just had to estimate that but they think there will be a lot more licensed next year than there is at this time but it does take some financial backing to get any licensure set up, machinery, set up to start the licensing of these people.
