PRESIDENT: You are closing, Senator?

SENATOR MILLS: I am closing. I'm trying to close on the confusion. There was some errors in the Committee amendment so we offered them the corrected amendment of which the amendment we're speaking about now is addressing. It is, as Senator Bereuter said, if it would have said "strike the new Section 3 added by the Committee amendment number 2, perhaps it would not have been so confusing but it is not doing anything. I assure you to any way affect that legislation that was passed by LB 577. It is not deleting anything. My amendment is merely bringing it into constitutional correctness and striking out any mention of surface water. The Committee will be bringing a bill to the floor, speaking of surface water but this will not. It is now very simple and I would ask you to adopt the amendment.

PRESIDENT: The question then is the adoption of Senator Mills' amendment to the Committee amendments. This requires a majority vote. Record your vote. Have you voted? Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Any further amendments to the Committee amendments?

CLERK: Nothing further, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion on the Committee amendments? Senator Bereuter, your light is still on. Is that from the previous discussion? Alright. Would you like to close, Senator Kremer? On the adoption of the Committee amendments?

SENATOR KREMER: Yes, sir. I have already moved, I move again that we...

PRESIDENT: Alright. You've heard the motion. Record your vote. This vote requires 25. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, on the adoption of the Committee amendments, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: They are adopted. Alright, we have another amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, I move to add the emergency clause to LB 217. That's offered by Senator Mills.

PRESIDENT: Senator Mills.

SENATOR MILLS: Mr. President, it's very simple. There are a number of districts that are trying to set the rules and regulations of controls. They need the action to take place as soon as they can so I'd ask you to adopt the emergency clause.
