SENATOR DeCAMP: Fair!

PRESIDENT: Yes.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Good grief! The word is "alien" here today.

PRESIDENT: But we can put these matters to votes. Now, Senator Dworak, and we were almost to an appeal on Senator Dworak's question. SENATOR DeCAMP: Not unless I can get enough votes and I don't have that at this point so I am going to work a little compromise.

PRESIDENT: What do you have before you now? The Mills amendment.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mills has an amendment.

CLERK: I have the Mills amendment, Mr. President, before us.

PRESIDENT: Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I talked to the proponents of the resolution. They indicated to me they were going to redraft the resolution, so as far as procedural points, and to end this this morning, I will just renew my objection and then it will become a moot issue. Then tomorrow they can come in with a new situation.

PRESIDENT: Then you are renewing your point of order?

SENATOR DWORAK: That is right.

PRESIDENT: I will sustain your point of order as previously made. All right. Does that conclude the matter then? You withdraw your amendment, then, Senator Mills? Fine. All right. Now we go to LR 150.

CLERK: Mr. President, LR 150 offered by Senator Koch of the 12th District. Read.

PRESIDENT: Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. President, members of the body, come let us reason together in good faith, speak softly. I promise I will do this for the rest of the day. This resolution
