Mr. President, Senator Simon asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 223 in the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: We now take up LB 64.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers asks unanimous consent to bracket LB 64 until January 16, 1978.
