PRESIDENT: Senator Carsten voting no.

CLERK: Senator Carsten voting no. Senator Menditte voting aye. Senator Goodrich voting aye. Senator Berentzen voting aye.

PRESIDENT: There is a motion to raise the Call. Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: I would ask for a roll call vote.

PRESIDENT: Call the roll.

CLERK: Roll call vote.

PRESIDENT: Senator Keves. All right, proceed with the roll.

CLERK: Roll call vote continued. (See pages 291 and 292, Legislative Journal.) 29 ayes, 7 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. Senator Newell moves that the Call be raised. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 23 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President.
