

CLERK: 18 ayes, 10 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: We are under Call. Would all Senators please return to your desks and record your presence. The Chair will accept or the Clerk will accept votes.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting no. Senator Clark had voted no.

PRESIDENT: We are under Call. Have you all recorded your presence? The Sergeant at Arms please find the absent members. Senator Labedz, would you indicate your presence? Senator Frank Lewis. Senator DeCamp.

CLERK: Senator Maresh voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hefner wants the roll called. Commence the roll.

CLERK: Roll call vote commenced.

PRESIDENT: We will now have roll call. Could we have some order on the floor so the Clerk can hear the responses.

CLERK: Roll call vote continued. (See page 200, Legislative Journal.) 23 ayes, 21 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion fails. Senator Frank Lewis moves that the Call be raised. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 22 ayes, 2 nays to raise the Call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Neil Simon wishes me to announce that he has a guest seated under the South balcony, Miss Marlene Maas from Crescent, Iowa and Senator Frank Lewis requests that she stand and be recognized. Thank you for being here, Miss Maas. We have another amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, I move to strike the word "energy" and add "natural gas". That is offered by Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President, members of the body, I add this amendment to strike the word "energy" and add "natural gas" because the rest of the resolution refers entirely to natural gas. We did have an amendment before us before that added the word "public utilities" but that was defeated and so this is a very simple amendment just to clarify the language a little bit and leave the other forms of energy out. Therefore, I would urge you to vote for this amendment.

PRESIDENT: The question is the adoption of Senator Hefner's amendment. Record your vote. Have you voted? Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 15 ayes, 14 nays, Mr. President.
