SENATOR KELLY: Mr. President, I move we advance LB 372 to E & R Final.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Senator Marsh requests a machine vote so a machine vote will be carried on this. Motion is the advancement of LB 372 to E & R Final. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Report the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 6 nays on the advancement, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: LB 372 is advanced. We will now try to take up before noon, Senator Fowler's....The Clerk would like to read some things in. Then we will take up Senator Fowler's bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, a new bill. LB 830. Title read. LB 831. Title read. LB 832. Title read. LB 833. Title read. LB 834. Title read. Mr. President, your committee on Public Health gives notice of cancellation of hearing for January 24. Mr. President, your committee on Miscellaneous Subjects gives notice of public hearings in hearing room 1019 for the week of January 19 and for the week of January 26. Mr. President, Senator Warner offers a motion to reconsider the motion to advance LB 394 from Select File to E & R for engrossing. I understand that needs to be laid over, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: That shall be laid over.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Maresh asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 109 in the Legislative Journal.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: We will then proceed on Select File with LB 233.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 233 has E & R amendments pending.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The Chair recognizes Senator Cullan.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 233 and there was a change made in the E & R amendments by myself because there was some concern about the intent of the introducer with respect to the E & R amendments that were initially submitted. Initially, the date was changed from 1978 to 1979. LB 233 deals with polling places and that would have, according to the introducer of the bill, violated his intent to have the requirement in effect by the general election and so the date was changed from January, 1978 to August of 1978 and that E & R amendment is submitted by myself and I think that that is consistent with the intent of the introducer and I move for the adoption of the amendments.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Motion is the adoption of the E & R amendments on LB 233. Any discussion. All those in favor of the....Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator, is that contained in the E & R amendments that I have in front of me or are you offering that as a separate amendment to these E & R amendments?

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
