

PRESIDENT: I don't know that.

SENATOR NEWELL: Anybody need some time to prepare one? Senator Brennan, do you need some time to prepare such a motion, to bracket it?

SENATOR BRENNAN: No, I don't think I need any time. It isn't written.

SENATOR NEWELL: Can we get it on the desk?

SENATOR BRENNAN: I'll put it on the desk.

SENATOR NEWELL: Fine. Since there is going to be such a motion I would like to speak briefly about the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Yes sir.

SENATOR MILLS: Speaking to the amendment, Mr. President?

PRESIDENT: I beg your pardon.

SENATOR MILLS: Is he speaking to the amendment, or to Senator Brennan's idea?

PRESIDENT: Point of inquiry. You are speaking to the amendment, aren't you Senator Newell?

SENATOR NEWELL: Yes, I am, Mr. Chairman.

PRESIDENT: All right. The point of inquiry...the answer is he is speaking to the amendment and not to the bracketing, Senator Mills.

SENATOR NEWELL: Jack, if you would have given me a second I would have said so too, just to clarify that. The point I would like to speak to is I also have had, like Senator Mills, Senator Cullian and numerous other people that have had some questions about this amendment and the purposes of this amendment and so forth. The committee amendments are not clear to me. I would like to know whether or not we are in compliance, or this would put us out of compliance. If, in fact, there is no danger being out of compliance then I can vote to take these committee amendments off. If, however, on the other side of the coin I find out that we will be out of compliance, I think it will cost the employers of the great State of Nebraska a great deal of money. I think that would be a bad situation. So if there is a motion up there, I'll just stop here and try to ask the body to indefinitely postpone.... Not indefinitely postpone.... Forgive me.

PRESIDENT: Read the motion.

CLERK: Read Brennan motion to bracket found on page 380 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT: Do you wish to speak to that, or do you want to call for the question?

SENATOR BRENNAN: I call for the question.
