SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Motion to indefinitely postpone fails. Senator Marsh. Motion to raise the Call. All those in favor of raising the Call vote aye, opposed nay. Report the votes.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The Call is raised. Are there any amendments now on this bill?

CLERK: Mr. President, I now have amendments, I think, offered by Senator Nichol.

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Clerk, may I issue amendments two and five of the Burrows amendments?

Mr. President, your Committee on Public Works gives notice of Public Hearing in the East Chamber for the week of February 9 and the week of February 15. Mr. President, Senator Schmit gives notice of executive session of the Ag Committee at 2:00 p.m. today, February 2,, in room 2230 to act on bills that we have heard. Mr. President, Senator Nichol asks to be excused on February 3rd. Mr. President, Senator Warner gives notice of public hearing in the Appropriations Hearing room for LB 923 for February 3. Mr. President, the Reference Committee refers LB 923 to the Appropriations Committee. Mr. President, I have an explanation of vote from the Constitutional Revision and Recreation Committee. Senator Venditte would like to be excused tomorrow, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: All right. No objection. So ordered. Anything else, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Duis asked unanimous consent to be excused the afternoons of February 7 and February 8.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Anything else?

CLERK: I have nothing further.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The Chair recognizes Senator Frank Lewis.
