LB 270, 216, 420, 501

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Senator Cullan.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move that LB 270 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: All in favor say aye, contrary say nay. The bill is advanced.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move the E & R amendments to LB 420 be adopted.

PRESIDENT: Discussion? All in favor say aye, contrary say nay. They are adopted.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I move that LB 420 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: All in favor say aye, contrary say nay. It is advanced.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move the E & R amendments to LB 216 be adopted.
