What this bill is is the recommendations by the Governor for deficiency appropriations for this year, and if it is introduced today, then it can be printed and we can set the public hearing and everything so it can be done next week. In addition to what has been recommended by the Governor which he is required to do by statute, there will be other deficiency requests from other departments which would be attached as amendments, if the Appropriations Committee would recommend that to the body. But the bill that you will be voting on is solely the deficiency recommendation on the part of the Governor and I want to make it clear that this is what it is and there may be others, but these are only those he recommends.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? The question is, shall the request be granted and this bill be introduced? Record your vote. Would you please vote? We are going to go under Call if you don't vote. Please vote. Record.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I request a Call of the House.

PRESIDENT: The question is, shall the House go under Call? The membership should pay more attention on these matters so that we can get our votes in. The question is, shall we go under Call? Record your vote. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 20 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: We are under Call. Will Senator Barnett please return to his Chair, and smile all the way, Senator Barnett. We are under Call. Please return to your desk, Senator Brennan. He is voting aye. And Senator Burrows is voting aye. And Senator Warner is voting to raise the Call. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 18 ayes, 0 nays to raise the Call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The Call is raised. Report the vote.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays on the Warner motion, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The Warner motion is adopted. Read the bill.

CLERK: New bill, Mr. President, LB 924. Title read.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marsh, for what purpose do you ask recognition.

SENATOR MARSH: So we can take 316 off of the Board. When people come in to vote when there is a Call of the House, it is very mixing up.

PRESIDENT: We go back to Select File. Senator Fowler, are you in any better position to take up 501 than you were earlier?

SENATOR FOWLER: No, I would like to lay it over until Monday.

PRESIDENT: All right, we go to 276 on Select then which is also yours, Senator Fowler. Do you want to take that up?

SENATOR FOWLER: Yes, sure.
