PRESIDENT: All in favor say aye, contrary say nay. They are adopted. Now Senator Maresh moves for unanimous consent to bracket LB 574....hold it over. Okay, is there an objection? Seeing none, it is so ordered. LB 502. Senator Cullan.

SENATOR CULLAN: Are there E & R amendments?

PRESIDENT: Yes.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move the E & R amendments to LB 502 be adopted.

PRESIDENT: All in favor say aye, contrary say nay. They are adopted. Do we have further amendments?

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move that LB 502 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Discussion? All in favor say aye, contrary say nay. The bill is advanced. Do you have anything on your desk? All right.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator George asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 361 in the Legislative Journal. Senator Mills asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 411 in the Legislative Journal. Senator Kelly asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 372 in the Legislative Journal. Senator Kelly asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 121 in the Journal. Senator Marvel asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 660 in the Journal and Senator Barnett asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 457 in the Legislative Journal. Mr. President, your committee on Revenue to whom was referred, whose Chairman is Senator Keyes, to whom was referred LB 800 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation that it be advanced to General File. Mr. President, your committee on Appropriations gives, first of all, Mr. President, I have a Reference Report referring LB 924 to the Appropriations Committee. Mr. President, notice of hearing for Thursday, February 9 by the Appropriations Committee on LB 924 and, finally, Mr. President, there is the motion with respect to appointments to the Nebraska Political Accountability and Disclosure Commission. The names that the Legislature chooses to submit will be inserted in the Legislative Journal and acted on at a later time as I understand it. Mr. President, Senator Newell asks unanimous consent to have his name added to LB 42 as a cointroducer.
