PRESIDENT: Senator Reutzel.

SENATOR REUTZEL: Mr. President, I rise in opposition to the Marsh amendment. It is a good amendment if you are from Lancaster County or Douglas County or where you are not a lot of college students coming in. What we are doing is making money for those two particular counties off of the inconvenience of several thousand students who cannot get back to their home counties at a particular given time in order to renew their licenses. I would hope that the body would defeat the Marsh amendment and move on and adopt the rest of the amendments and expedite this bill.

PRESIDENT: Senator Lamb.

SENATOR LAMB: Just to respond to Senator Dworak's comments and Senator Reutzel's. I think the issue here is that we are trying to make it more convenient for the people. I think it is a real inconvenience for people to have to go back to their home county in all cases to get their license and I see no harm in having the county keep the fee that does the work, and in that way, we can accommodate the people to a greater degree and I still support Senator Marsh's amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Cope.

SENATOR COPE: Mr. President, members, I would support the amendment of Senator Marsh. I don't believe if you'd talk to the county officials that this is that much of a money maker. I feel that they have about that much time and expense invested in it and certainly the town and cities like Lincoln or Lancaster County, I should say, are going to do the work and I think they should be compensated for it.

PRESIDENT: Senator Rumery.

SENATOR RUMERY: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I rise to support the Marsh amendment. It seems like we have debated this subject quite thoroughly so I would move the previous question.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: Mr. President, this is not a moneymaking proposition for the counties. I hope you will go talk to your county officials and quickly. This is not a moneymaking proposition for the county. It is simply a way to cover the cost for the county who is doing the issuing. This is not a way for Douglas County nor Lancaster County nor any other county to make money. It is simply a way for them to recover their expenses for providing the service to your people and your county may be providing that service for someone from another county. It is to help the counties which do the work. Please contact your county officials so that you will know that what I am telling you is accurate.
