

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Senator Maxey.

SENATOR MAXEY: I rise in support of this amendment. I think this will clear up the tax schedule. It also will inform the people who own mobile homes that they are being separated, and of course given a way to appeal.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Any further discussion? All those in favor of the adoption of...this is one of three amendments, Senator Marvel, is that correct? The first Marvel-Maxey amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Amendment to LB 660. It would be nice if we could do without a Call of the House. We are voting on the first of three amendments by Senator Marvel and Senator Maxey on LB 660. Have you all voted. Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the Marvel-Maxey amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The first amendment is adopted. Senator Marvel.

CLERK: Mr. President, I now have another amendment offered by Senators Marvel and Maxey. Read second amendment found on page 568 of the Journal.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: I want to check, first of all, with Senator Maxey. Do you need to withdraw your amendment, first, before this one is offered?

SENATOR MAXEY: Yes. I need to withdraw my amendment on page 569.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Senator Marvel, the Clerk advised me that that amendment was adopted. So it will have to be formally... we'll have to have another amendment to.... Actually it's a reconsideration.

SENATOR MARVEL: Can we do it by unanimous consent?

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: No, we have to have a motion on it. You want to take that up first then? Senator Marvel, if you want to withdraw, temporarily, your motion.

SENATOR MARVEL: I'll just withhold amendment number two until the other matter is settled.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Let's take up the Maxey motion to take care of this. Mr. Clerk, will you read that amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, the Maxey amendment reads as follows. Read amendment found on page 567 of the Journal.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Senator Maxey.

SENATOR MAXEY: Mr. President, fellow senators, I had some troubles with this. Some of this is unconstitutional. I believe, since we do have a constitutional problem here, that it would be best to strike this amendment and then Senator Marvel and I have come to an agreement. We're going to support these other two amendments. I move that we strike this amendment.
