LB 447, 585, 656

PRESIDENT: Any further debate? The question is the advancement of the bill, LB 447. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on the advancement, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. LB 585.

CLERK: Mr. President, (Read title to LB 585). The bill was first read...well the bill was referred to the Miscellaneous Subcommittee, Mr. President. There are pending Committee amendments by Senator Dworak's Miscellaneous Subjects Committee.

PRESIDENT: Would you like to handle the Committee amendments? This is Senator Dworak's Committee, I understand. Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Unless there is someone else on the Committee that wants to handle them. What the Committee amendments did there was to make the draft copies, the working copies of rules and regulations, amended or repealed, to be available to the public and to include a declaration of availability that they are there for public examinations so I would move that the Committee amendments be adopted.

PRESIDENT: Any discussion? The question is the adoption of the Committee amendments. Record your vote. Please vote. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the Committee amendments, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: They are adopted. Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: LB 585 is a bill introduced by Administrative Rules and Regulations Committee and all it does with the exception of what the Committee amendments just did is increase the length of time from ten to twenty days that the Revisor of Rules and Regulations should receive the rule and regulation from the agency that has adopted them. The reason for this, bringing it to them that many days is because of the difference between what may be a mailing day and another day that they walk in and hand it to them and of course the Rules and Regulations Revisor must get these out to the folks who are subscribers and also to all the counties so it requires more days than the ten days originally planned for. With that I'd move the advancement of the bill.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? The question is the advancement of the bill. Record your vote. Please vote. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the advancement of the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 656.

CLERK: Mr. President, (Read title to LB 656). The bill was first read on January 5, 1978. It was referred to the Banking, Commerce and Insurance Committee. It was advanced to General File, Mr. President. There are Committee amendments pending.

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
