

SENATOR GOODRICH: Mr. President, members of the body, Senator Dworak indicated that there might be some effect on the City of Omaha if this bill is passed. He's absolutely right. The City of Omaha now has a \$3.2 million problem each year with the Court of Industrial Relations mandated increase of 14 percent average salary increase on police officers, the same thing is coming on firemen and civilian workers. That problem totals about \$3.2 million per year, which you all know about, and you'll hear more about Monday. This particular bill, if passed in its present form, would cost the City of Omaha approximately another \$4 million in lost revenue. Now if, as Senator Chambers indicates in his remarks that he may be willing to be required or have to change the nature of the bill to just an increased refund from the state, that is a little different story. But if it's passed in its present form it will add to the financial burden of the City of Omaha another \$4 million, for a total of about \$7 to \$7½ million per year if this particular bill gets passed in its present form. That's all I need to do, just give you the information. Thank you.

SENATOR MARVEL: Senator Chambers, do you wish to close?

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays to raise the Call, Mr. President.
