CLERK: 26 ayes, 3 nays on the motion to cease debate, Mr. President.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Senator Nichol for closing.

SENATOR NICHOL: I will only say that the way the bill is now it is impossible to work. The parties for and the parties against refuse to budge on it. I don't know what you could do on this in the situation it is. I ask to kill the bill.

SENATOR SAVAGE: The question is the withdrawal of LB 18 requested by Senator Nichol. All those in favor vote aye. Opposed vote nay. It takes a simple majority. Record. Chair recognizes Senator Dworak, for what purpose?

CLERK: 27 ayes, 6 nays on the motion to withdraw, Mr. President.

SENATOR SAVAGE: The Clerk has some things to read into the record.

CLERK: Mr. President, a Reference Report referring bills 942 through 944. Mr. President, your Committee on Public Works gives notice of public hearing in the East Chamber for Thursday, February 23. Mr. President, Senator Schmit asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 424 in the Legislative Journal. Senator Nichol asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 121 in the Journal. Senator Barnett asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 212 in the Legislative Journal.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Is that all, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Ed Dworak asks to be excused on February 21st all day. Mr. President, Senator Frank Lewis makes the motion to reconsider our action on LB 620. That will properly be laid over.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Mr. President, in view of the fact that the Government Committee will be meeting at 1:30 and there are various luncheons today, I am going to ask that we recess until 2 p.m.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Motion to recess until 2 p.m. All those in favor say aye. Opposed. We are in recess.
