Mr. President, Attorney General opinion #192 addressed to Senator Warner and Senator Koch regarding LB 663. (See pages 765-767.) All those will be inserted in the Legislative Journal in full. Mr. President, your Committee on Committees wishes to report regarding the following gubernatorial appointments. There are four committee reports, Mr. President. Those properly should be laid over.
