SENATOR DeCAMP: It is a two pronged thing. In other words, first of all, we will have to change the statute which this is the bill for. Second of all, I have already got the rule in to do it. It doesn't matter to me. I am just trying to expedite the process in here. Whatever you want to do.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Probably the place to discuss this would be if the bill is introduced at a hearing. All right. Any further discussion? Then the motion is to introduce the bill. It requires 30 votes. All those in favor of Senator DeCamp's motion vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? This requires 30 votes. While we are waiting for the votes, the Chair would like to take this opportunity to introduce on behalf of the Treasurer, Frank Marsh, Mrs. Fonda Thomsen, Laboratory Manager of the Bertrand Conservation Laboratory, who is over under the North balcony. Would Mrs. Thomsen stand. Welcome to your Legislature. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to introduce, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Motion carries. The bill is introduced.

CLERK: A new bill, Mr. President, LB 948. Title read.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Anything else, Mr. Clerk? Read them in.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a Reference Report referring LB 945 directly to General File and that is signed by the members of the Reference Committee. Mr. President, Senator Barnett asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 748 in the Legislative Journal. Mr. President, I have a corrected committee statement for LB 657. Mr. President, LB 912A introduced by Senator Keyes. Title read.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: We still have a couple of motions. Senator Labeledz, bring to your attention, I think we will just go ahead and take up these other motions and not take up 407 this morning because I don't think it would be fair to you to have a fifteen minute time period to do it, do you agree? So let's take the rest, Senator Labeledz. Yes, whenever we return to General File. It remains pending as is. So let's take up the next motion then.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Barnett asks unanimous consent to bracket LB 623 until March 2.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Is there any objection?

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Mr. President, if you don't mind, I would like to know what the number is.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Do you object, Senator Lewis?

CLERK: 623.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: I do a temporary objection right now. That is fine, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: All right. Anybody object? So ordered.
