PRESIDENT: All rise for the morning prayer.

CHAPLAIN: Prayer.

PRESIDENT: The Legislature will please come to order. Roll call. Record your presence. Record your presence, please.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Venditte, George and F. Lewis would like...Senators George and Venditte would like to be excused until they arrive and F. Lewis excused all day, Mr. President. Senator Labeledz would like to be excused until she arrives, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Have you all recorded your presence? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Could I have your attention please. Ray Wilson, the Sergeant at Arms, has asked me to request, again, that members please advise the Sergeant at Arms of their whereabouts when they leave the Chamber if it is for a destination other than their office or a committee hearing. CLERK: I have none, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Are there corrections from the floor? The Journal shall stand. Notices, reports and announcements.

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Business and Labor gives notice of a corrected hearing schedule set for Wednesday, February 22. Mr. President, your Committee on Public Health, Chairman Senator Richard Lewis, to whom was referred LR 152, instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File. Mr. President, your Committee on Urban Affairs offers corrected standing committee reports to LB 558 and 591.

PRESIDENT: Do you have any new bills?

CLERK: I have no new bills, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: We go to Final Reading. All senators are to be at their desks. We will now commence reading of LB 323.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read title to LB 323.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with the question is shall LB 323 pass. Record your vote. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read record vote found on page 800 of the Journal.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I'm sorry. I'd like a roll call vote.

PRESIDENT: All right, call the roll.

CLERK: Took roll call vote found on page 800 of the Journal. 29 ayes, 14 nays, Mr. President.
