

to put the city council under the provisions of the sunshine act because I felt what was good for the county board of supervisors, county commissioners, is also good for school board members, is also good for city councils. Senator Simon and others refused and Senator Simon basically said that that might create too much opposition to the Political Accountability and Disclosure Commission's activities and I think if we are going to be consistent, we should reject this amendment, or if we are going to do anything, we should put the city councils under, not just an appointed advisory board to the city council. So I would urge you to reject these amendments. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Senator Clark.

SENATOR CLARK: Mr. President, members, I would like to ask Senator Beretuer a question, please.

SENATOR BEREUTER: Yes, sir.

SENATOR CLARK: Who is going to report for these people, you say, collectively, who would do that?

SENATOR BEREUTER: If you would adopt this amendment, it would give a planning commission the option to report for all nine of its members with their permission in a single report.

SENATOR CLARK: Would you also go for an amendment that the Clerk of the Legislature would report for all of us?

SENATOR BEREUTER: No, I don't think he would have that knowledge.

SENATOR CLARK: I don't think the planning commission does either.

SENATOR BEREUTER: I don't either, except, Senator Clark, that there is a provision that I think is pending there which would require that only the real estate holdings of planning commissioners be reported and I would think that he would have that knowledge.

SENATOR CLARK: I would wonder if we could have a division of the question so we could vote on both, whether the planning commission would be able to do this collectively or whether we put them under the Sunshine Act.

PRESIDENT: Could I see the amendment, please. Would you advise the Chair as to where you want this divided?

SENATOR CLARK: What I am wanting is, I could go for the amendment to put them all under this but I could not go for the part of the amendment that says that they would collectively be reported by the planning commission itself, all nine members. I would like to see everyone under the sunshine amendment or do away with the thing. Now I will go with Senator Cullan in saying that everyone ought to be under it or no one. I think Senator Beretuer has a question.

SENATOR BEREUTER: Senator Clark, if you wanted to divide it, the amendment, it would be the last new sentence added to the amendment beginning on lines 26 and 27 of page 2 and continuing on page 3, line 1. It would read "Such descriptions may
