

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The question then is the reconsideration of LB 323. Yes, Senator Venditte. For what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR VENDITTE: Mr. President, I request a Call of the House.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Motion for Call of the House. I think that's a reasonable request. All those in favor vote aye. Opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 22 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The House is under Call. All legislators will return to their desks. All nonlegislative personnel will leave the floor of the Legislature. All legislators will please register your presence. We will proceed.... Did you request a roll call vote. All right, Senator DeCamp, I'll wait for your further instructions at that point. Make sure we get the people in here. Will the Sergeant at Arms please bring in the committee which is meeting in the Supreme Court Hearing Room, I believe. Senator Nichol, are you with us? I know you're not against us. Would you register your presence please. Senator Hasebroock. Bill. While we're waiting for the members to come in, the Chair would like to take this opportunity to introduce to the Legislature, Margaret Bisset, Frieda Glass and Ella Mae Glup, friends of Senator Brennan, who are under the South balcony. Would they please stand up and be recognized. Welcome to your Legislature. Senator George, are you still here? Senator Schmit, I think you're here. Senator Moylan. Would you register your presence. Senator Newell. Senator Kelly. While we're waiting also Senator Koch would like to have me introduce some ladies from the Ralston area, under the North balcony. We have people from Senator Koch's district too. Would they stand up and be recognized, from Ralston here. Welcome to your Legislature. We'll go to a vote on the machine. Machine vote as soon as the Clerk explains the issue. Mr. Clerk, will you read the motion.

CLERK: Mr. President, the motion is to reconsider our action on final passage of LB 323.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: This will require 30 votes to reconsider this action. All those in favor vote aye. Opposed nay. Record the vote. Record the vote.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 10 nays on the motion to reconsider, Mr. President.
