

Democratic Womens Club. Senator Dave Newell asked that they be introduced. They are in the south balcony. Would the ladies stand up and be recognized? Welcome to your Legislature. All right, any further discussion on the Simon motion? Senator Simon. Does everybody understand the motion? All those in favor of the Simon motion vote aye, opposed nay. This requires twenty five votes. Please let us vote so that we can get on with the motions. We have several other motions that we would like to take care of yet this morning. Has everybody voted? Has everybody voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The motion is adopted. We cannot take up the Maresh motion then at this time. Senator Maresh is not here. Senator Keyes is not here so we will go to Senator Murphy's LB 534.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Murphy moves to return LB 534 to Select File for specific amendment. The specific amendment is on page 2, line 26 strike "may" and insert "shall".

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The Chair recognizes Senator Murphy.

SENATOR MURPHY: Gentlemen, if we may, this will take but a minute. This is an amendment that so far we have adopted three times but it is still in Final Reading due to some kind of..., well it is still in the Final Reading bill and I would like to bring the bill back with Senator DeCamp's concurrence as in the past two times we adopted it, to once more make the correction and substitute "shall" for "may". It is an issue that, like I say, we have adopted it twice before. If we adopt it one more time I think we have got it. I would move that the bill be returned for that specific amendment.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The Chair recognizes Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DE CAMP: I concur completely. I would just ask that once it is done, we expedite it and then maybe send a guardian along to make sure the "may" and "shall" doesn't get lost. As he says, we have adopted it twice. This will be the third time. Somehow it gets lost every time.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Any further discussion? Senator Murphy, anything else on closing? The motion then is the Murphy motion to return LB 534 for the specific amendment for the technical correction. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? We're voting on the Murphy motion to return LB 534. Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, on the motion to return, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: LB 534 is returned. I think we will go right ahead, Senator Murphy, and take it up. We will consider ourselves on Select File for the purpose of taking it up. Senator Murphy.

SENATOR MURPHY: I move that the amendment, now that the bill is returned, the amendment be adopted.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Motion to adopt the amendment on LB 534. Is there any further discussion? All those in favor of adopting the Murphy amendment to LB 534 vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Senator Marsh, I'll wait for you. Record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the Murphy amendment, Mr. President.
