CLERK: Senator Frank Lewis voting aye. Senator Newell voting aye. Senator Maresh voting aye. Senator Schmit voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Report the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator John Savage moves that the Call be raised. Record your vote. Have you voted? Record.

CLERK: 18 ayes, 5 nays to raise the Call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The Call is raised. The bill is advanced. Read the A bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, (Read title to LB 198 A.) The bill was read on May 9, 1977. Mr. President, Senator Maxey has a amendment on the A bill. On page two, line one, strike "3" and insert "2", strike line two and insert \$145,939 from "the". On line three strike "1977" and insert "1978" and line four, strike "1978" and insert "1979". That is offered by Senator Joann Maxey.

SENATOR MAXEY: Mr. President, that is an old Fiscal note. There should be another one on the desk.

CLERK: I am reading the A bill, Senator.

SENATOR MAXEY: Yes, the A bill. Right. There should be a new one.
