There are members who stood on this floor and I'm going to get the transcription of the comments made by the members when Senator DeCamp stood up here and asked to extend the time. No matter how feisty members of the Legislature get, or how uncomfortable, or impatient, I'm going to do these things. As long as the Legislature does what it does, I'm going to do what I do. This bill is very symbolic of what the Legislature is about. It does not symbolize strength. It does not symbolize study. It does not symbolize thought or understanding of the lawmaking process. It symbolizes a group of people who will not look at the issue which we have been told is before us. The bill will not benefit the manufacturers of Nebraska. Allegedly, that is what it is all about.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Chair recognizes the acting Speaker. Senator Chambers, he's asked for permission to....

SENATOR MARVEL: Are you through?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: No, but we've done everything else in that fashion, we may as well do it now. So if you're going to cut me off then I'll....

SENATOR SAVAGE: I'm not cutting you off. I have to recognize the man in command.

SENATOR MARVEL: I have a motion to recess, but I will wait till Senator Chambers time is up. Go ahead.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Proceed, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Because Senator Marvel and I were on the campaign trail together, and I understand that when lunch time comes my philosophy has always been when the stomach is full the head is empty, but I guess that works to the contrary in the Legislature. The dinner bell is calling. The lobbyists are waiting. In deference to the Legislature in its hustling to the dinner table, I'm going to give up whatever time I had and let the chips lie where they fall.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Senator Chambers, I'd like to correct one item. The Appropriations Committee is meeting this noon to have a public hearing. So the dinner bell isn't tolling for the Appropriations Committee. Chair recognizes Senator Marvel's motion to recess until what time?

SENATOR MARVEL: One-thirty.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Until 1:30. All those in favor say aye. Opposed. Let's have a machine vote. Have you all voted? Record. We are adjourned.

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
