Senator Maxey is excused. Senator Maxey, will you record your presence? Senator Keyes, will you record your presence? Senator Schmit, will you record your presence please? Senator DeCamp. Senator Simon. Senator Kahle. Senator Kahle, will you record your presence please? Is Senator Cullan here? Senator Simon, we are under Call. Senator Mills.
