SENATOR MILLS: We all know that. I want to try to do what you want to do, Senator Kremer, but you are not leading us anywhere.

SENATOR KREMER: If you want to do that, then will you please sit down.

SENATOR MILLS: Mr. Chairman, I will respect the wisdom of my elders at this time.

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman, speaking to Senator Mills, he always said I am a nice guy and I wanted to prove to him that I wasn't always nice.

SENATOR MARVEL: Senator Mills, you do not object. Okay, if there is no objection, LB 411 will be laid over until tomorrow. How about 395?

CLERK: There are E & R amendments, Mr. President.
