LB 153, 407, 541

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Barnett asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 407, never mind...

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Never mind. We'll accept the never mind. Okay, anything else, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: I have nothing further, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Proceed then with Select File. Item 7 on the agenda. Beginning then with LB 541. The Chair recognizes Senator Cullan.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, and members of the Legislature, I move the E & R amendments to LB 541 be adopted.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The motion has been made and seconded to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 541. Is there any discussion? All those in favor signify by saying aye. Opposed nay. The E & R amendments are adopted on LB 541. Senator Cullan.

SENATOR NEWELL: I'd like to bracket this bill until Thursday.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: All right. Is that a unanimous consent request?

SENATOR NEWELL: Please. Unanimous consent.
