SPEAKER LUEDTKE PRESIDING

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The Legislature will come to order. Register your presence please. Record the presence. Record.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Before we get started I'd like to just re-iterate something that was announced here yesterday with the Statehood Day coming up tomorrow morning at approximately 11:30, the birthday cake in the rotunda as we have had in years gone by and with a special invitation to members of the Legislature to tour the Ferguson house immediately thereafter with a luncheon being provided over there for the Legislators, I might add that they should have mentioned that any of the spouses that want to accompany their husbands or wives are invited to come along and if there are any of you who now know that your spouse can attend, we had one or two, but we do not have all of you, would you let me know so that... Do you want to just put up your hands now and I can just add that many and if you find out later this afternoon, let me know. There is at least another one or two here. Okay. So let me know if your spouse can go to lunch at the Ferguson house after the Statehood Day tomorrow. Fine. All right. Yes. Senator Venditte. Question?

SENATOR VENDITTE: Point of order, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Senator Venditte.

SENATOR VENDITTE: An inquiry, Mr. President, relative to the agenda set for Friday. I understand that there was a page circulating on the floor yesterday.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: I know nothing about it.

SENATOR VENDITTE: Well I know I had given my...but I was wondering if the results of that vote had been tallied.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: I don't know anything about it. No one has provided me with it. The Speaker announced that we wouldn't meet Friday unless someone desires to move to meet Friday to change the Speaker's order, it's alright. I announced last Friday so that people knew what they were going to do, that we were not going to meet Friday, the 3rd, nor the Good Friday and I announced that way last week and unless somebody changes the order, affirmatively by twenty-five votes on the floor that's the way it's going to be. Anything else, Mr. Clerk?

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: While the Legislature is in session and capable of doing business I propose to sign and I do sign LB 259, LB 534, LB 551, LB 552, LB 628, LB 863, LB 327, LB 574, LB 574 A.
