SENATOR F. LEWIS: Senator Simon, we are under Call. The rules provide no lobbying on the floor. Senator Richard Lewis voting aye. Senator Shirley Marsh voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Rasmussen voting no. Senator Keyes voting no. Senator Savage voting aye. Senator Hasebroock voting aye.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Senator Cal Carsten voting no. Senator Goodrich voting aye. Senator Bereuter voting no. Senator Senator Ramery voting aye. Senator Warner voting no. Those of you who have just come in if you'd record your presence so we can make sure we get a count. We need Senator Chambers and Senator Venditte. Senator Chambers and Venditte are the ones that are absent, Senator Simon. What are your desires? If he is, the Clerk doesn't know.

SENATOR SIMON: Call the roll.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Senator Simon has asked for a roll call vote.

CLERK: Took roll call vote found on pages 982 and 983 of the Journal. 25 ayes, 13 nays, Mr. President.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: The bill is advanced by unanimous consent. Next bill on the agenda is LB (machine malfunction). Senator John DeCamp. Read. Move is to raise the Call. All those in favor vote aye. Those opposed vote no. Clear the board and let's vote. Record. Call is raised.

CLERK: 15 ayes, 0 nays to raise the Call, Mr. President. Mr. President, new bill. Read title to LB 795A. Mr. President, new bill. Read title to LB 928A. Mr. President, your Committee on Public Works, whose Chairman is Senator Kremer, to whom was referred LB 784, instructs me to report the same to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File with amendments.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Senator DeCamp. LB 351, it's a Revenue Committee bill.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Well Senator Labeledz and Senator Venditte and a couple of others interested in the bill aren't here. I said, if it's agreeable with everybody, I'll wait till they get back, five or six days. It's an important bill.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Are you asking that that be bracketed to a time certain?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Yes, I think we better. Till next week. Wednesday, Tuesday, whenever you want.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Senator DeCamp asks unanimous consent to bracket the bill till next Wednesday. Any objection? If not, so ordered. LB 192, Senator Burrows. That's bracketed. LB 640. Senator Newell asks that LB 640 be laid over till tomorrow. Are there objections? If not, it's so ordered. LB 92. Senator Goodrich. Senator Stoney, are you ready on 169? Senator Barnett. Are you ready on 169?

SENATOR BARNETT: Yep.
