SPEAKER LUEDTKE PRESIDING

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The Legislature will come to order.
Register your presence.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senators Dworak, Marvel and Chambers
ask to be excused until they arrive. Senators Brennan and
Schmit ask to be excused until they arrive, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Senator Maresh, are you here? Record the
presence, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: We will proceed then. Do you have some
matters to read in?

CLERK: Mr. President, LR 169 which was adopted by this body
this morning is now ready for your signature.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: While the Legislature is in session and
capable of doing business, I propose to sign and I do sign
LR 169.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Barnett asks unanimous consent
to print amendments to LB 331 in the Legislative Journal, 248
in the Legislative Journal and amendments to 385 in the Legis-
lative Journal.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Ready for General File. First number on
the agenda, item number eleven on General File is LB 92 A.
We'll go on then to LB 351. All right, then we'll go to LB 640.

CLERK: Read title to LB 640. The bill was read on January 4,
1978. It was referred to the Revenue Committee. It was ad-
vanced to General File, Mr. President. There are Committee
amendments pending by Senator Keyes' Revenue Committee.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Senator Duis, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR DUIS: To query the Chair please? Senator Labeledz made
known to me that she would very much like to be here when 640
was heard because it is very similar to her Homestead Exemption
bill and I would ask of Senator Burrows if he would be kind
enough to pass over this until Senator Labeledz is able to be
present. I guess she has been excused.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Does anybody know whether she has been
excused for the day?

SENATOR BURROWS: This was a Revenue Committee bill and I'd
rather leave that up to Senator Keyes and Senator Newell that
was the subcommittee chairperson on the bill.
