SENATOR BARNETT: I would move for the adoption of the Committee amendments and then I have to amend the Committee amendments, right, Pat?

CLERK: Senator, I have two Committee statements from you. I assume one is a corrected version but I'm not sure which one is which. How did you want it to read? Can you tell me?

SENATOR BARNETT: Okay. The Committee amendments, now do you want the amendment or the statement?

CLERK: I want the Committee statement that you want the body to consider right now.

SENATOR BARNETT: Okay, let me see if I've got it corrected in my book.

CLERK: I thought we had offered a corrected statement to it.

SENATOR BARNETT: We printed it, I believe, and I think we may have the corrected one now. The bill drafter brought it up, remember?

CLERK: Yes.

SENATOR BARNETT: They had made a mistake and this was the corrected copy. Ernie, I believe it is right now in the Committee as you have it and it should read beginning with six in line twenty four. Right. I believe that's right. I would move for the adoption of that Committee amendment and then I'll check it over. Wait, that's not right.

CLERK: Which one though? I need ...

SENATOR BARNETT: How do I identify it to you. It says on page two.

CLERK: Well it's either within a reasonable time after or?

SENATOR BARNETT: No. A reasonable time after.

CLERK: And that's your corrected Committee report?

SENATOR BARNETT: That's correct.

CLERK: Okay, thank you.

SENATOR BARNETT: I would move for the adoption of that amendment and then what I would do is check that out and make sure that its drafted correctly. What it does, it strikes out the six months of the effective date of this act and sets in within a reasonable time of this act and Senator Chambers will explain the act. It does not tie the Supreme Court down to any length of time or it does not tie the Supreme Court within six months of this date of this act so with that, I'd move for the adoption of the Committee amendment.
