to the institutions in the development of the information system and the two amendments or the one amendment with two sections that are being offered, one is it states that each institution and the Coordinating Commission would file by January 15 the estimate of their costs in the development of this uniform data system, the elements that will be used this year, and then they will file that with the Legislative Performance Review and Audit Committee which, in turn, would review and then make a recommendation to the Exec Board of the Legislative Council as to whether or not or what portion of those expenditures should be reimbursed. It should have been a part of the bill originally. It is necessary in order to authorize and justify the expenditure provided in the A bill.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? The question is, shall LB 597 be returned for the specific amendment? Record your vote. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill is returned, Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move adoption of the amendment as I have explained it.

PRESIDENT: Discussion? Record your vote. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the Warner amendment, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Senator Warner, do you move to readvance the bill?

SENATOR WARNER: Yes, I do.

PRESIDENT: All in favor say aye, contrary say nay. The bill is advanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports that we have carefully examined LB 568 and find the same correctly enrolled; 571 correctly enrolled; 625 correctly enrolled; 723 correctly enrolled; 724 correctly enrolled; 869 correctly enrolled.

PRESIDENT: While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do hereby sign LB 568, 571, 625, 723, 724 and 969. Do you have anything further, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: I have nothing further, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: We will go back to the special order then on Senator Barnett's matter, LB 623. The Chair recognizes Senator Barnett.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 623 was a bill introduced by the Judiciary Committee and signed by the members thereof. Title read. The bill was read on January 4, 1978. It was referred to the Judiciary Committee. It was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending, Mr. President.

SENATOR BARNETT: Pat, the committee amendments, that is the white copy, isn't it? We have to move to adopt that, right?

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
