

appointment procedure to the Board of Examiners and that it should be open to any qualified cosmetologist. The amendment then provides for this. Section 8, page 10, deals with funding, requires that expenditures match recent references. This again was requested by the Department of Health. Next change is found in section 9, provides for statutory statement that matches the current practice. Section 10, it refers to a statement that deals with reference in section 4, subsection 5. Section 11 provides a statute that matches current practice. Section 12 provides a statute that matches current practice. Section 13 clarifies use of cosmetology instructors in schools of cosmetology. Section 14 provides a statute that matches current practice and 15 reestablishes a manicurist fee. Most of these, as you can see, are just corrective amendments, technical amendments, and I would move for their adoption.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Are they committee amendments? Motion then is to adopt the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Will you please vote? Please vote. We can get a lot more work done if we can take care of this business at hand. Senator Savage voting aye and record.

CLERK: Senator Savage voting aye. 26 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the committee amendments, Mr. President.
