

PRESIDENT: The question is the adoption of Senator John DeCamp's amendment. Record your vote.

CLERK: The motion is Senator DeCamp's amendments, Senator. Page 1012 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: Record. Report the vote.

CLERK: 18 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator DeCamp moves that the bill be advanced. Record your vote. All right. Record this vote. The question is shall the House go under Call. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 15 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The House is under Call. All senators are to return to their desks and record their presence. Chair recognizes Senator Luedtke.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Just an announcement concerning the County Extension Board's luncheon that was scheduled on the East Campus, the luncheon tomorrow afternoon. That has been cancelled and will be reset for Monday, April the 3rd. So if anybody is worried about it, it is cancelled, the one for tomorrow. Reset to April 3rd.

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner, Senator Lamb, Senator Kelly. Senator Brennan, would you record your presence. Call the roll.

CLERK: Took roll call vote found on page 1032 of the Journal. 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on motion to advance.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. Senator Shirley Marsh moves that the Call be raised. Seconded by Senator Savage. Yes sir.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: I might just ask the body if you don't want to stay here, if you want to adjourn till Monday, I'll make the motion. But if you want to stay here and work, let's work because we've got over 30 people here. We ought to be able to take care of these bills. But if we're going to have to wait five or ten minutes before every vote we just as well go home. There are a lot of people that feel that way. Now either let's keep enough people here and work, or let's go home.

PRESIDENT: Do you want to close argument on your motion to raise the Call, Senator Marsh? The question then is shall the Call be raised. Record your vote. Have you all voted? The motion fails. We are still under Call. The Sergeant at Arms shall secure the membership. We have 34 that.... Would you please record your presence now. We had 34 a couple minutes ago. Please record your presence. We are under Call. Senator Schmit. Senator George. Would the Sergeant at Arms find Senator George. Senator Goodrich, we are under Call. Please return to your desk and record your presence, and stay at your desk. Senator Shirley Marsh. Senator George was just under the North balcony. We are still waiting for two senators. Would the Sergeant at Arms find Senator George, please. We just had that vote. All right. Senator George is temporarily excused. We now go to LB... Which one, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: LB 826. Read title to LB 826. The bill was read on January 12, 1978. It was referred to the Banking Committee. It was advanced to General File. There are no committee amendments, Mr. President.
