took the concept and put it over where we are awarding, whatever the monies may be, we are awarding insurance benefits for a single or a man with dependents, and we are acknowledging, in that section where we make that award, that we do intend to differentiate and pay for dependents when a man has them. That was the sole intent of this bill. I understand the Appropriations Committee has a new change in fees. In that appropriations bill they have also inserted...the Governor has inserted this same language. However, if that particular bill should not pass it would leave us without that language. I would suggest we adopt this committee amendment, which was really my amendment. Adopt this amendment. Then if the appropriation bill comes along it won't change it. But if the appropriation bill does not come along at least it will be in there. But it's just authorizing the fact...acknowledges the fact that we have two different payments, one intended to cover the dependents of an employee.

SENATOR COPE: Okay. Thanks much.

PRESIDENT: Do you care to respond, Senator DeCamp? The question is the adoption of the committee amendments. Record your vote. Record. No, no, no, no. We are under Call, senators. All senators are to be at their desks. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the committee amendments, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The committee amendments are adopted. Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: I move the bill be advanced as amended.

PRESIDENT: Record your vote. We are under Call. Some senators have slipped out on us here. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business I propose to sign and do hereby sign LR 172, LR 171.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have notice of hearing by Committee on Committees for March 16th, and again on March 22nd. Mr. President, Senator Rasmussen asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 632 in the Legislative Journal. Senator Richard Lewis asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 560 in the Legislative Journal.

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
