PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 37 ayes, 0 nays to bracket, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill is bracketed. That completes Final Reading. Do you have some new bills, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner moves to introduce Request #1497 and Request #1498 by the Appropriations Committee.

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move that the two bills be introduced. The one deals with the cash funded agencies. The other one deals with the operating agencies for the various constitutional offices and I move that they be introduced. There will be another one or two or three to be introduced during the course of the day as they become available.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? These will be taken separately, Senator Warner. Record your vote on the first request. Record.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays to introduce the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: All right, now the other request. That request is granted. Senator Warner, the other one. We are taking them separately, Senator. The Chair recognizes Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: As I indicated, the second one deals with the operational budget for the various constitutional agencies, the Legislative Council, the courts, the Governor's, the Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, Attorney General, State Auditor, the Treasurer, the Public Service Commission.

PRESIDENT: Record your vote. Record. Excuse me. We will have to record again. We had a malfunction of the presiding officer. Please record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 36 ayes, 0 nays to introduce the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: That request is granted. We have in the North balcony fourteen Political Science students from Chadron State College. That is in Senator Cullan's District. Thank you for being with us this morning. We also have in both balconies twenty-seven fourth grade students from Arnold Elementary here in Lincoln. That is in Senator Warner's District. Now would you read the bills, please.

CLERK: Mr. President, new bills, LB 951 introduced by the Appropriations Committee. Title read. LB 952 introduced by the Appropriations Committee and signed by the members thereof. Title read.

PRESIDENT: We now go to Item #7 for a period of one hour on these motions. The first one is Senator Bereuter's regarding LB 707.

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
