LB 508, 574

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Rumery moves to return LB 508 to Select File for specific amendment. That amendment being to add the emergency clause.

SENATOR MARVEL: You have heard the motion, is there a second to the motion? All those in favor of returning the bill to Select File for specific amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. 25 votes. Voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Marvel voting aye.

SENATOR MARVEL: Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

SENATOR MARVEL: The motion is carried and the bill is back on Select File. Now, Senator Rumery, do you move the adoption of the amendment?

SENATOR RUMERY: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move the adoption of this amendment.

SENATOR MARVEL: You have heard the motion. Is there a second to the motion? All those in favor of the adoption of the specific amendment to LB 508 vote aye, opposed vote no. Voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Marvel voting aye.

SENATOR MARVEL: Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to adopt the Rumery amendment, Mr. President.

SENATOR MARVEL: The motion is carried and the amendment is adopted and the emergency clause has been added to the bill. Now, Senator Rumery, do you move that the bill be advanced to E & R for engrossment?

SENATOR RUMERY: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move LB 508 be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

SENATOR MARVEL: Is there a second to the motion? All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried. The bill is advanced. Okay, are we ready for the next area which is Select File? We are ready for Select File and the first bill is LB 153. What is the status of 153? With the Speaker's permission, I will recognize Senator Maresch for a motion before we go to Select File. Senator Maresch.

SENATOR MARESH: Mr. President, will the Clerk please read the motion.

CLERK: Mr. President, I move to direct the Clerk to request the Governor to return LB 574 to the Legislature for further consideration and it is offered by Senator Maresch.

SENATOR MARESH: Members of the Legislature, this is the bill that we passed last week. It has to do with issuing temporary permits for people that are out of the state or out of the country. The Governor objects to a certain provision in the bill which involves the State Treasurer in this process of issuing the permits and I think if we can bring the bill back, this can be worked out.
