SENATOR MARVEL: Senator Bereuter.

SENATOR BEREUTER: Mr. President, we have had substantial discussion and I have no objection to Senator DeCamp's intent nor the language he is providing and I would encourage the adoption of his amendment.

SENATOR MARVEL: The motion and the second is to adopt the DeCamp amendment to 697. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Voting aye, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Marvel voting aye.

SENATOR MARVEL: Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the motion to adopt Senator DeCamp's amendment.

SENATOR MARVEL: The motion is carried and the amendment is adopted. Are there any other amendments to this bill?

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR MARVEL: Senator Bereuter, do you want to move advancement of the bill?

SENATOR BEREUTER: I move again for the advancement of LB 697 to E & R Final.

SENATOR MARVEL: Is there a second? All those in favor say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. Bill is advanced. What are we doing on 109A? Now what is the status of 407 and 047A?

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 407, the E & R amendments were adopted by the body on February 24, 1978. I now have pending an amendment offered by Senator George. Is Senator George here?

SENATOR MARVEL: Is that the first amendment?

CLERK: Yes, sir. Senator George, the amendment can be found on page 753 of the Legislative Journal.

SENATOR MARVEL: Senator George, do you move the adoption of your amendment?

SENATOR GEORGE: Yes, Mr. President, I move adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR MARVEL: Is there a second to that motion? It has been moved and seconded that the George amendment to 407 be adopted. The Chair recognizes Senator George.

SENATOR GEORGE: Mr. Chairman and members, the amendment is part of, well, originally, historically speaking, it was LB 392. LB 392 is still held in Revenue Committee. Then the Revenue Committee moved to combine LB 392 with LB 407. This, of course, was contained in the committee

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
