

LB 407: Read. (See page 1056, Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: Senator Carsten.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this is basically a clerical error or a misplacement in the bill. I talked to Emory Burnett and Bruce Cutshall about it, and while they felt they could do it on E & R, they felt that really the proper procedure was to do it by way of amendment and it just replaces it in its proper place as opposed to where it was. It was just an improper drafting, in their opinion, to begin with. So I move for the adoption of the amendment, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Record your vote. Have you voted? Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Carsten's amendment.

PRESIDENT: It is adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Maxey now moves to amend LB 407. Her amendment can be found on page 986 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: Senator Maxey.

SENATOR MAXEY: Mr. President, and fellow Senators, my amendment to 407 is corrective. As you know, I had an Attorney General's opinion printed in the Journal and mobile homes is constitutional and we needed to make some corrective language in here and define what mobile home is and this is all my amendment does and I move the adoption of the amendment to 407.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? Record. Record your vote. Have you voted? Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Maxey's amendment, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: It is adopted, Senator Maxey.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator DeCamp now moves to amend LB 407. Senator DeCamp's amendment can be found starting on page 818 of the Legislative Journal.

SENATOR DeCAMP: I have a question of Bernice first, are you going to try to move this bill today?

SENATOR LABEDZ: No, as I promised, I am going to wait until the budget bills are heard.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Okay, I will leave my amendment up there because I think when you get some more information, Bernice, and when Senator George gets some information on the impact, you may think this is a good amendment.

SENATOR LABEDZ: I have already read it, Senator DeCamp, and this is not a good amendment.

SENATOR DeCAMP: You wait until you get some more numbers, Bernice.
